Learn how to build and increase distance skills! Focus will be on teaching your dog to move ahead as well as work laterally away from you. This seminar will help your team gain the understanding and confidence needed to enhance and increase distance skills and will include sequences to teach directionals while incorporating more distance into the exercises; when, where and how to cue your dog properly using body language, verbal cues and motion; how to be more clear, crisp, consistent and calm in your handling. Sequences/Courses will be presented that will push each team for distance according to their level of training. Advanced teams will be pushed to gain more distance and novice teams will work on gaining distance skills.

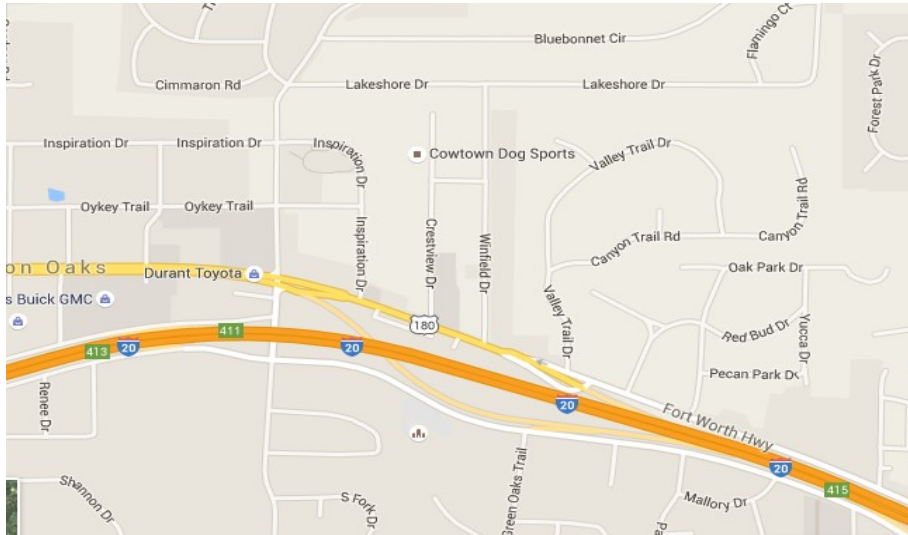
